

# 2024 Quality Foods Sand Sculpting Competition

On behalf of the Parksville Beach Festival Society, it is our pleasure to invite you to apply to compete at the Quality Foods Sand Sculpting Competition July 11-14, 2024.

The event will be held at the Parksville Community Park - 193 Island Hwy East in Parksville, British Columbia, Canada.

We invite sand sculptors to apply for one of fifteen solo spots and/or seven double spots available in the competition. Applications need to be submitted online on or before March 1, 2024. You may apply as both a Solo and a Double, but you will be selected for one or the other as Soloists and Doubles compete at the same time. Doubles must complete an application that includes both partners' names, contact information and accomplishments.

Applications will be evaluated by the Parksville Beach Festival Society Board of Directors in early March. All applicants (whether selected or not) will be notified by email no later than March 17, 2024.

Selection criteria when evaluating an application include:

- Whether you can speak and communicate in English,
- The number of times you have placed in the top 5 at your regional competitions as we need to be sure your sculpting is at a professional level,
- The quality of your work as determined by your competition placements,
- Photos of your work,
- Your references and how easy you are to work with (as determined by our committee, and your reputation within the industry),
- How much you anticipate your travel costs will be. It is ideal if international applicants can minimize their travel costs by sharing their travel expenses with other North American competitions such as Revere Beach; this will help your application considerably. The maximum reimbursement for travel for all sculptors will be \$2,400 CDN for international travel or \$1,400 CDN within North America per sculptor, regardless of actual costs.

If selected you, we will ask for your top 3 preferred plots and we will assign them once we have heard from all competitors.

Prize money will be awarded as follows in Canadian funds:

We will also include a Competitor's Choice award as voted by your peers, as well as a People's Choice award as voted by the public during the 5-week exhibition. The winning double and soloist will receive \$250 CDN per person for Competitor's Choice and \$500 CDN per person for People's Choice.



All sculptors receive a \$2,000 CDN appearance fee regardless, if they place or not.

# The Sculpting Schedule will take place as follows:

Wednesday, July 10: Sculptors travel to the Parksville, BC, which is located on Vancouver Island. You will be responsible for the cost of your meals on Wednesday, but we will reimburse your travel costs (airfare, ferry, gas). If flying into YVR (Vancouver International Airport) we will take care of your return flight from Vancouver to Qualicum Beach/Nanaimo on Vancouver Island. One of our society members will pick you up and transfer you to your motel. Try to arrive as early in the day as possible so that you can come to the competition site in the afternoon to select and build your forms. We do encourage you to order your forms in advance so we can have them ready and set aside for you. We have both wood and a small amount of flexi forms available.

#### Meals

All meals will be provided during the competition for all participating sculptors. This includes Thursday breakfast, lunch, and dinner; Friday breakfast, lunch, and dinner; Saturday breakfast, lunch, and dinner; and Sunday breakfast and lunch. In addition, coffee, tea, water and snacks will be available on site throughout the day.

Spouses and children are welcome to attend the Friday dinner and the Saturday Sponsor Event; however, please advise if you will be bringing a guest. Lunches are for competitors only. You will be responsible for your own meals before Thursday as well as on Sunday night. If you have any special dietary requests, please let us know on your registration form.

## Accommodations

The Parksville Beach Festival will book and pay for your accommodations from Wednesday July 11 - Sunday July 14 (up to 5 nights). Please advise if you do not require lodging, or if you require accommodations outside of these dates, or if you have any special needs. Most rooms are double occupancy, and you will be paired with another competitor (but you'll have your own bed!). We will circulate a list of confirmed competitors so you can let us know if there is someone you would like to share with. If you choose to book your own room, or bring a guest, you will be responsible for payment.

#### Travel & COVID-19

The Parksville Beach Festival will pay your travel costs, up to a maximum of \$2,400 CDN for international travel or \$1,400 CDN within North America per sculptor. Please make your travel arrangements early and submit your estimated costs on your application form. If you are flying, please book economy class. If you are driving, we strongly suggest that you make ferry reservations to and from the event, since this is a busy time for <u>BC Ferries</u>.

To be reimbursed, please submit your original receipts before August 30, 2024. Expenses submitted after this date will not be reimbursed!

In keeping with the Society's duty of care and our responsibility as an event host, the Parksville Beach Festival Society is guided by recommendations from the Province of British Columbia and will abide by the legal mandates of the Provincial Health Officer, at the time of the 2024 Quality Foods Sand Sculpting Competition.

Coming together has numerous benefits, not the least of which are solidifying and showing care for our community. By attending the competition, participants accept responsibility to act in the best interests of their health, the health of others who attend, and the communities to which they will return after the Event.

As such, participants will:

- Follow the BCCDC guidance, "Self-Isolation and Self-Monitoring" for people with (or exposed to) COVID-19, found at <a href="http://www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid-19/self-isolation">http://www.bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid-19/self-isolation</a>
- Not participate with COVID-19 symptoms
- Depart the Event if COVID-19 symptoms develop

The BCCDC recommends that people wear masks for all indoor events when community levels of infection are deemed high. We ask that all attendees respect participants' personal choices with respect to wearing a mask.
